<b>Islam</b>	A religion followed by Muslims
<b>Qur'an</b>	The sacred scripture of Islam
<b>Mosque</b>	A place of worship where Muslim people attend to read
<b>Prophet Muhammed</b>	Prophet of God (Allah)
<b>Compare</b>	When you look at and compare the similarities and differences between things
<b>Revelation</b>	a message to humans from a divine being

1. Who visited Muhammad in the First Revelation?
2. What did he do when the Angel gave him a message?
3. Where should the Qur'an be kept?
4. How should we show respect before reading the Qur'an?
5. Can you remember one of the five pillars of Islam?

### The story of the "Night of Power".

1. Muhammad was alone on the mountain.
2. The angel Jibril (Gabriel) appeared to him.

4. Muhammad memorised and understood the words exactly.
