ISLAM – SIGNIFICANT BELIEFS ABOUT GOD

VOCABULARY

Muhammad	an Arab religious leader and the person who started Islam.
Makkah	the religious capital of Saudi Arabia and the Muslim world. It is also known as Mecca.
Monotheism	the belief that there is only one supreme being.
Shahadah	The Shahadah is the declaration of faith or the key statement of belief of Muslims.
Prophet	a person who predicts the future.
Benevolent	The desire to do good for others
Omnipotent	possessing infinite power; all-powerful.
Disrespectful	Having a lack of respect about someone or something
Belief	A strong opinion about or trust in a thing or person or idea.
God	a being that is worshipped and believed to have special powers over nature or life.
