Communication challenge:

Each newsletter we will be adding a communication challenge for you to complete at home. We understand that time is precious and with busy lives it may be hard to complete tasks so hopefully they are small challenges that you can incorporate into your daily routines. If you are able to send in pictures, photos or comments when completing the challenges, we would enjoy sharing these with the group.

The first challenge is to 'Talk about tomorrow'

Have a conversation each day with your child about what the plan is for the following day. Although this could be the same each day, encourage the use of different words: *tomorrow*, *future*, *day names*, *the next day, morning*, *afternoon*, *evening*. The conversation could last for one minute or ten minutes depending on the engagement of your child. Can you do this every day for a week?

This is important for children to be able to differentiate between past and present something we also work on at preschool.
