## School Life

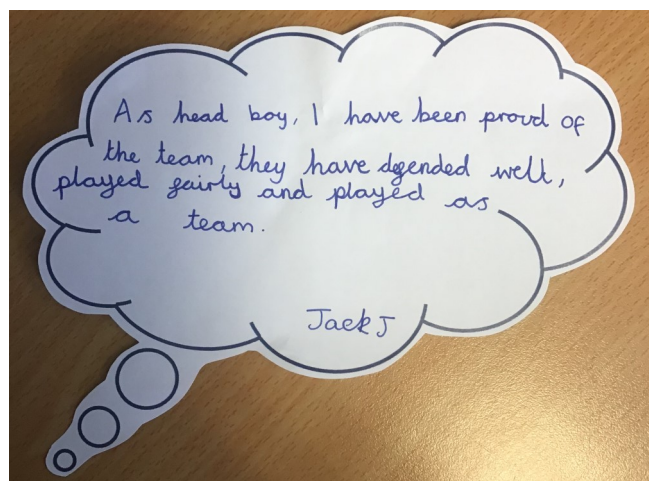
The Children in Need donations have highlighted how many Parents don't have school life or are not reading the messages sent.

They won every small match they played and came 3<sup>rd</sup> overall! There were 9 schools and 12 teams overall so this is a fantastic achievement!



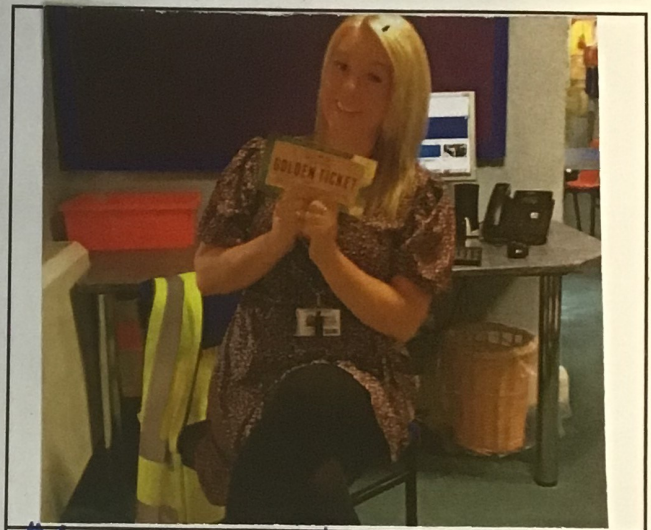
